## CORRIGENDUM

During the second reading of the text on 21 July 2000 the Moldovan Parliament introduced a number of changes that did not appear in the text of 5 July 2000. These changes are as follows:

1. **Article 73** (the President's right to initiate legislation) was kept in its original form (Constitution of 1994).

2. **Article 86** was left unchanged:

(1) the President has the right to lead negotiations and conclude international treaties; In paragraphs (2) and (3) the President retains the right to appoint and dismiss diplomatic representatives.

3. **Article 89** paragraph (2) was changed as follows:

“The President may give to Parliament **and the Constitutional Court** explanations concerning acts attributed to him.”

4. **Article 98** has been completed by a new paragraph (4):

“The President appoints the government on the basis of the vote of confidence by the Parliament.”

Paragraphs (4) and (5) become (5) and (6) respectively.

5. In **Article 135** paragraph (1) letter a), the word “regulations” has been excluded.
