The following activities took place between the 85th and 86th meetings of the Council for Democratic Elections:

- Participation in the *Ad Hoc* Committee of the Parliamentary Assembly of the Council of Europe to observe the early elections to the Assembly of Kosovo, 28 December 2025.
- Post-Election Analysis Conference “Parliamentary Election in the Republic of Moldova, 28 September 2025: Electoral Integrity and Perspectives for Democratic Consolidation”, Chişinău, Republic of Moldova, 19–20 February 2026.

The following activities are foreseen after the 86th meeting of the Council for Democratic Elections:

- Symposium on the 30th anniversary of Japan's observer status with the Council of Europe - “Artificial Intelligence as a challenge and an opportunity in the development of advanced democracies”, Strasbourg, France, 13 March 2026.
- Participation in the post-electoral evaluation seminar: “The implementation of the Single Paper Ballot in the 2025 legislative elections; prospects for the 2027 presidential elections”, Buenos Aires, Argentina, 17 March 2026.
- Participation in the *Ad Hoc* Committee of the Parliamentary Assembly of the Council of Europe to observe the parliamentary elections in Hungary, 12 April 2026.
- Joint debate “Towards Trusted and Inclusive Electoral Processes: The Role of Observers”, organised by the Parliamentary Assembly, the Congress of Local and Regional authorities and the Venice Commission of the Council of Europe, Paris, France, 28-29 April 2026.
