1. Adoption of the agenda

The Council is invited to adopt its agenda as it appears in the present document.

2. Media monitoring during election observation missions

The Council is invited to adopt the comments on media monitoring during election observation missions by Ms Herdis Thorgeirsdottir and Mr Masters (CDL-EL(2004)012 and 013; cf. the "Guidelines on media monitoring during election observations missions" by the OSCE).

3. Forms for election observation

The Council is invited to adopt the draft simplified version of the election observation forms prepared by Mr Casagrande, and the comments provided by Mr Owen on this draft (CDL-EL(2004)014 and 015; cf. CDL-EL(2004)019 and CDL-AD(2003)010).

4. Electoral rules and affirmative action for national minorities

The Council is invited to adopt the report on electoral rules and affirmative action for national minorities, prepared by Ms Lazarova Trajkovska (<u>CDL-EL(2004)020</u>).

5. Revision of the Armenian Electoral Code

The Council is invited to adopt the draft joint opinion of the Venice Commission and OSCE/ODIHR on the draft amendments to the electoral code of Armenia, on the basis of comments by Messrs Annus, Hjörtur Torfason and Pilgrim (<u>CDL-EL(2004)016</u>; see documents <u>CDL(2004)074</u>, <u>CDL(2003)052</u>, <u>CDL-AD(2003)021</u> et the additional considerations by experts of the Venice Commission and OSCE/ODIHR of March 2004).

6. "Vota" database

The Secretariat will inform about progress on the "vota" database.

7. Co-operation with other organisations

Ms Dezsö will inform the Council about the annual ACEEEO conference, held in Tirana on 9-11 September 2004.

The Secretariat will inform the Council about the meeting on election support held in Brussels on 28-29 September 2004, and in particular on the question of principles for international election observation.

8. Future activities

The members are invited to submit proposals for future activities.
