The Council is invited to examine with a view to approval, the draft joint opinion by the Venice Commission and the OSCE/ODIHR (CDL(2022)047) on the constitutional and legal framework governing the functioning of democratic institutions of Serbia (CDL-REF(2022)051 / 053 / 054 / 055 / 056), drawn-up on the basis of comments by Mr Eirik Holmøyvik, Mr Oliver Kask, Mr Oscar Sánchez Muñoz and Ms Elena Kovalyova for the OSCE/ODIHR. This joint opinion was requested by Mr Michael Aastrup Jensen, Chairman of the Monitoring Committee of the Parliamentary Assembly of the Council of Europe, 18 November 2021.

3. Georgia – Draft joint opinion of the Venice Commission and the OSCE/ODIHR on draft amendments to the Election Code

4. Republic of Moldova – Draft Amicus curiae brief on declaring a political party unconstitutional
