- 1 Constitutional Justice new footnote "This chapter as the Systematic Thesaurus in general should be used restrictively, as the keywords in it should only be used if a relevant question is raised. This chapter is thus not used to establish statistical data; rather, the Bulletin reader or user of the CODICES database should only find decisions under this chapter when the subject of the keyword is an issue in the case."
- 2.1 Sources of constitutional law –Categories: add footnote: "Only for issues concerning applicability and not simple application".
- 3.21 General principles Equality: in footnote 44 delete sentence "Also refers to the principle of non-discrimination on the basis of nationality as it is applied in Community law.". This EU principle should be dealt with together with similar issues under the chapter 5.2.2.4 Fundamental Rights Equality Criteria of distinction Citizenship.
- 4.7.4.3 Institutions Judicial bodies Organisation Prosecutors / State counsel: new footnote: "Notwithstanding the question to which to branch of state power the prosecutor belongs"
- 4.8.6.1.1 Institutions Federalism, regionalism and local self-government Institutional aspects Deliberative assembly **Status of members**.
- 5.1.3 Fundamental Rights General questions Limits and restrictions: add footnote "The criteria of the limitation of human hights (legality, legitimate purpose/general interest, proportionality) are indexed in chapter 3."
- 5.1.3 Fundamental Rights General questions Limits and restrictions **Non-derogable rights.**
- 5.1.3 Fundamental Rights General questions Limits and restrictions General/special clause of limitation.
- 5.1.3 Fundamental Rights General questions Limits and restrictions Subsequent review of limitation.
- 5.1.4 Fundamental Rights- General questions: add to footnote 97 "Includes questions of the suspension of rights".
- 5.2.2.4 Fundamental Rights- Equality- Criteria of distinction Citizenship or nationality.
