## **7. World Conference of Constitutional Justice**

The Secretariat will inform the participants about the results of the World Conference on Constitutional Justice held in Cape Town on 23-24 January 2009 and on the progress made in the establishment of the World Conference as a permanent body.

A meeting of the Bureau established by virtue of the declaration adopted in Cape Town ([http://www.venice.coe.int/WCCJ/WCCJ\\_E.asp](http://www.venice.coe.int/WCCJ/WCCJ_E.asp)) took place in Mérida, Mexico on 16 April 2008. With the assistance of the Secretariat, the Bureau prepared a draft Statute of the World Conference (CDL-JU(2009)\*, link [http://www.venice.coe.int/WCCJ/Statute/WCCJ\\_Statute\\_2009\\_04\\_16\\_ENG.doc](http://www.venice.coe.int/WCCJ/Statute/WCCJ_Statute_2009_04_16_ENG.doc)), to be submitted to the regional and linguistic groups for comments and approval.

According to the draft Statute, the Joint Council on Constitutional Justice is invited become a founding group of the World Conference. This will give the Courts represented in the Joint Council the opportunity to become members of the World Conference under a simplified procedure (Article 2.b). It is true that most of the courts participating in the Joint Council are also members of another regional or linguistic group. Membership of the Joint Council on Constitutional Justice will therefore mostly benefit courts that belong to no other group (e.g. Finland, Sweden, USA), which could benefit from a simplified accession to the World Conference if the Joint Council adhered.

In addition, the Venice Commission’s co-operation agreements with the various groups provide for a representation of the groups in the Joint Council. Membership of the Joint Council on Constitutional Justice in the World Conference would therefore provide an element of co-ordination for the work with the groups within the World Conference.

**The participants will be asked to approve the current draft of the Statute and to invite the co-presidents to represent the Joint Council at the next meeting of the Bureau, which will take place on the occasion of the Plenary Session of the Commission in Venice on 11-12 December 2009, which will adopt the final text.**

**8. Seminars with Constitutional Courts (CoCoSem)**

The Secretariat will inform the participants about the seminars held since the last meeting as well as the programme of future CoCoSem seminars and will present the updated guidelines for the organisation of seminars (CDL-JU(2009)002).

## **9.b. Participation of the Constitutional Court of Belarus in the Bulletin**

**Following an informal discussion of the possible re-inclusion of the case-law of the Constitutional Court of Belarus in the Bulletin at the last meeting of the Joint Council in Tirana, the participants will be asked to decide on this issue.**

Background: Following the adoption of a new Constitution of Belarus by referendum and the renewal of the Constitutional Court, the Venice Commission had suspended the publication of the Court's case-law in the Bulletin. In 2002, the Conference of European Constitutional Courts asked the Commission to resume contact with the Court and since then the Commission organised three conferences with the Court (2003, 2004, 2008). The Joint Council had decided to present the Belarus case-law as a special working document in an annex to the Bulletin and to include them in CODICES with a special note ([CDL-JU-PV\(2003\)001](#), [CDL-JU-PV\(2004\)001](#)).

## **9.c Special Bulletins**

The Secretariat will present the work on the special Bulletin on "Basic Texts 8".

**The participants will be invited to decide on their readiness to prepare a working document followed by a special Bulletin on the topic to be chosen by the Circle of Presidents of the Conference of European Constitutional Courts for the XV<sup>th</sup> Congress (Bucharest, 15-16 October 2009).**

## **10. CODICES database**

### **10.a Presentation of a new version of CODICES**

The Secretariat will present version 5.4 2008/2of CODICES. This version should include the following new features:

1. A new presentation of the Systematic Thesaurus, which is closer to the paper version (feature included in version 5.3, 2008/1). **The participants will be asked to either approve this new presentation or request that the previous presentation be restored.**
2. The possibility of a new (restricted) Internet site which includes the précis that are still being processed (link to follow). This version of CODICES should replace the present Interim Bulletin site (<http://www.venice.coe.int/JU/Bulletin>) and allow searches in CODICES including in the most recent case-law. **The participants will be asked to decide whether they would like to have the précis reviewed on a public or restricted site.**
3. Direct links in the Internet version to précis, full texts, constitutions, laws and descriptions (see also point 10.b below for one of the uses of this feature).
4. Inclusion of the Systematic Thesaurus in both Portuguese and Spanish by virtue of the co-operation agreement with the Ibero-American Conference of Constitutional Justice (see also point 6.f above).
5. Inclusion of non ANSI texts (Cyrillic, Arabic, etc.) in HTML format rather than in Word format, which facilitates searches.

### **10.b Updating and indexing constitutions and laws in CODICES**

The liaison officers will be invited to inform the Secretariat of the changes made to their country's constitutions, laws on the courts and descriptions as compared to the texts contained in CODICES. Following the establishment of direct and stable links to these documents on the CODICES site (see point 9.a.3 above), the Secretariat will present its project to send these links to the liaison officers asking them to check whether they are up to date together with the

invitation to contribute to the bulletin. This should give the liaison officers the opportunity to verify more quickly whether all data is updated.

The Secretariat will inform the participants on the progress made in the indexing of constitutions and laws on the courts on an article by article basis (see also state of updating in document CDL-JU(2008)006).

#### **10.c Data input mask**

The liaison officers will be reminded to use input masks for their contributions (for off-line version Microsoft Access required, mask available on CD-ROM and downloadable at [www.venice.coe.int/ju/mask20.mdb](http://www.venice.coe.int/ju/mask20.mdb) and the Internet mask at [www.venice.coe.int/ju/codices](http://www.venice.coe.int/ju/codices)).

#### **11. Documentation Centre on Constitutional Justice / Library**

The Secretariat will express its gratitude to the participating courts for providing their publications to the Documentation Centre. #### **12. Version 20 of the Systematic Thesaurus**

Given that there are very few proposals for changes of version 20 of the Systematic Thesaurus, the working group will not meet. The only proposal so far is a technical one and it concerns one keyword 4.9.11 in French which should be “determination of votes” instead of “*recensement*” in order to be aligned with the English “Determination of votes”. **The participants will be asked to approve the Secretariat’s proposal to accept this change in the existing version 20 without formally adopting a new version.**

The next meeting of the Joint Council on Constitutional Justice could take place in May or June 2010 in Venice unless a participating court would like to host the Commission or make a proposal for future venues.
