# 2. Armenia – Joint opinion of the Venice Commission and ODIHR on the draft amendments to the Electoral Code and related legislation

The Council is invited to examine with a view to approval, the draft joint opinion of the Venice Commission and ODHIR (<u>CDL(2023)035</u>) on the draft amendments to the Electoral Code and related legislation of Armenia (<u>CDL-REF(2023)028</u>), drawn up on the basis of comments by Mr Oliver Kask, Mr Tomáš Langášek, Ms Katharina Pabel and Ms Tamara Otiashvili (ODIHR expert). This joint opinion was requested by the Minister of Justice of Armenia on 12 June 2023.

The joint opinion was prepared under the <u>Quick Response Mechanism (QRM)</u> in the framework of the EU/CoE joint programme <u>Partnership for Good Governance</u>, co-funded by the Council of Europe and the European Union and implemented by the Council of Europe.
