Amendments to the Turkish code on criminal procedure related to criminal judgeships of peace

Art. 268, paragraph 3(b) [as amended in 2021]:

The review of appeals made against the decisions of the Magistrate's Court regarding detention and judicial control shall be the responsibility of the judge of the criminal court of first instance located within the judicial district. In cases where the competent authority for examining the appeal is different, the necessary measures shall be taken by the Magistrate's Court that issued the decision to ensure the appeal is reviewed without delay. If the matters of the Magistrate's Court are being handled by the criminal court of first instance judge, the authority to review the appeal belongs to the president of the Assize Court.
