Open governance principles

- Government transparency is understood as the disclosure and information and subsequent accessibility of relevant government data
- Public integrity refers to the consistent alignment of, and adherence to, shared ethical values, principles and norms for interests in the public sector. upholding and prioritising the public interest over private

- Accountability refers to the governments' responsibility and officials duty to inform its citizens about the decisions it makes as well as to provide an account of the activities and performance of the entire government and its public
