- Recommendation 1: The Venice Commission should provide a detailed overview
  of the scope and core areas of its work for additional clarity and review its rules
  of procedure in light of current challenges and demands.
- Recommendation 7: Revise the rules of procedure in respect of the process for the appointment of members to help ensure the highest standards of independence and technical knowledge.
- Recommendation 8: Review the working methods of the Venice Commission to formalise certain processes and procedures to ensure greater clarity and transparency while retaining a sufficient degree of flexibility.
- Recommendation 10: Consider the development of an internal monitoring and evaluation framework to help increase internal insights on the extent of the Venice Commission's impact.
